# OUR RECORD

The history of the Menasha Lions Club has been unusual. Thirty years ago on March 31, 1936, we received our Charter from Lions International with 25 members listed on the roster. Things went smoothly for twenty years, we were a good active Club. Then for some unknown reason our membership and activeness began to deteriorate. In fact we almost disbanded in 1958. However, through the untiring effort of our State Secretary Shafeec Mansour, we regrouped our forces and have since grown into a strong and active Club once again. We will always be grateful to him for this, for without him we would not be celebrating this important occasion today.

Just how active we are can be seen by the number of projects we participate in each year. We recently held our Sportsmans Show, the most successful since we originated it 20 years ago. Our annual light bulb sale is looked forward to by the people in the community and has been getting better every year. We also sell special Lions Club "Trick or Treat Candy" at Halloween. We have sold many things in the past to raise funds, including safety flares, American flags and magazines to mention a few. We help the local merchants make their annual sidewalk sales successful by participating with a brat and refreshment stand. These are a few of our projects, we have had more.

We are not only busy raising money, but have been busy putting it to use as well. Several times we have purchased equipment for Theda Clark Memorial Hospital. The most recent being an anatomical torso, eye, heart and skeleton. We helped get the Menasha Auxilliary Police started by purchasing equipment for them. We have also given them cash donations as well as to other civic groups. Among them, the Community Chest, Red Cross, Easter Seal Society, Winnebago County Association for Mental Health, Winnebago County Guidance Center, Menasha Recreation Department and many more. We also sponsor a team in the Babe Ruth baseball league each year.

At Christmas time we contribute money to buy gifts for people confined to Winnebago State Hospital. We also provide several needy families with baskets of food and gifts for the children.

Each year we sponsor several visually handicapped children to the Wisconsin Lions Camp for the Visually Handicapped at Rosholt. We purchased 10 space heaters for cabins at the camp as well as made cash donations to it's general fund. Other projects for the blind and visually handicapped, where the purchasing of Braille writers and watches. Countless numbers of eye examinations and glasses as well as eye surgery for needy children have been paid for from our funds.

We could go on and on, but we do not wish to sound too boastful. However, we are very proud of our accomplishments and very proud to be members of this fine organization ---- the Menasha Lions Club.
