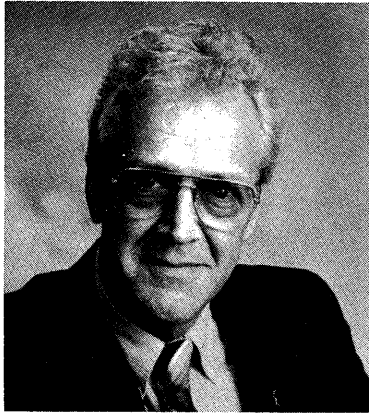
Past Director Fukushima is in the insurance industry.
