District 27-B1 Second Vice District Governor Dave Holschbach recently presented Manitowoc Lion Paul Tittl a Melvin Jones Fellowship on behalf of the Lions of District 27-B1. Lion Tittl is the 25th Assembly District Representative and worked also with State Senator Andre Jacque. A Melvin Jones Fellowship is recognition of humanitarian work and given to an individual that demonstrates this. Lion Paul was instrumental in getting WISCONSIN ACT 257 eye glass bill recently signed by Governor Evers. This bill creates an exemption from liability for charitable organizations that provides previously owned eyeglasses to an individual such as Wisconsin Lions Foundation. Lions Foundation can now use recycled glasses within our own state. This idea started four years ago. Lion Tittl was quoted, "More than four years ago, the eyeglass recycling manager for the Wisconsin Lions Foundation told me of the eyeglass liability problem and wondered if I would work to get the law changed...I was happy to watch Governor Evers sign it today."
