- July 1971 Elkhart Lake Lions Club formed.  
New Holstein and Elkhart both sponsored by WES.
- Dec. 1973 First Christmas baskets given out.

- Sept. 8, 1976 Bingo started.

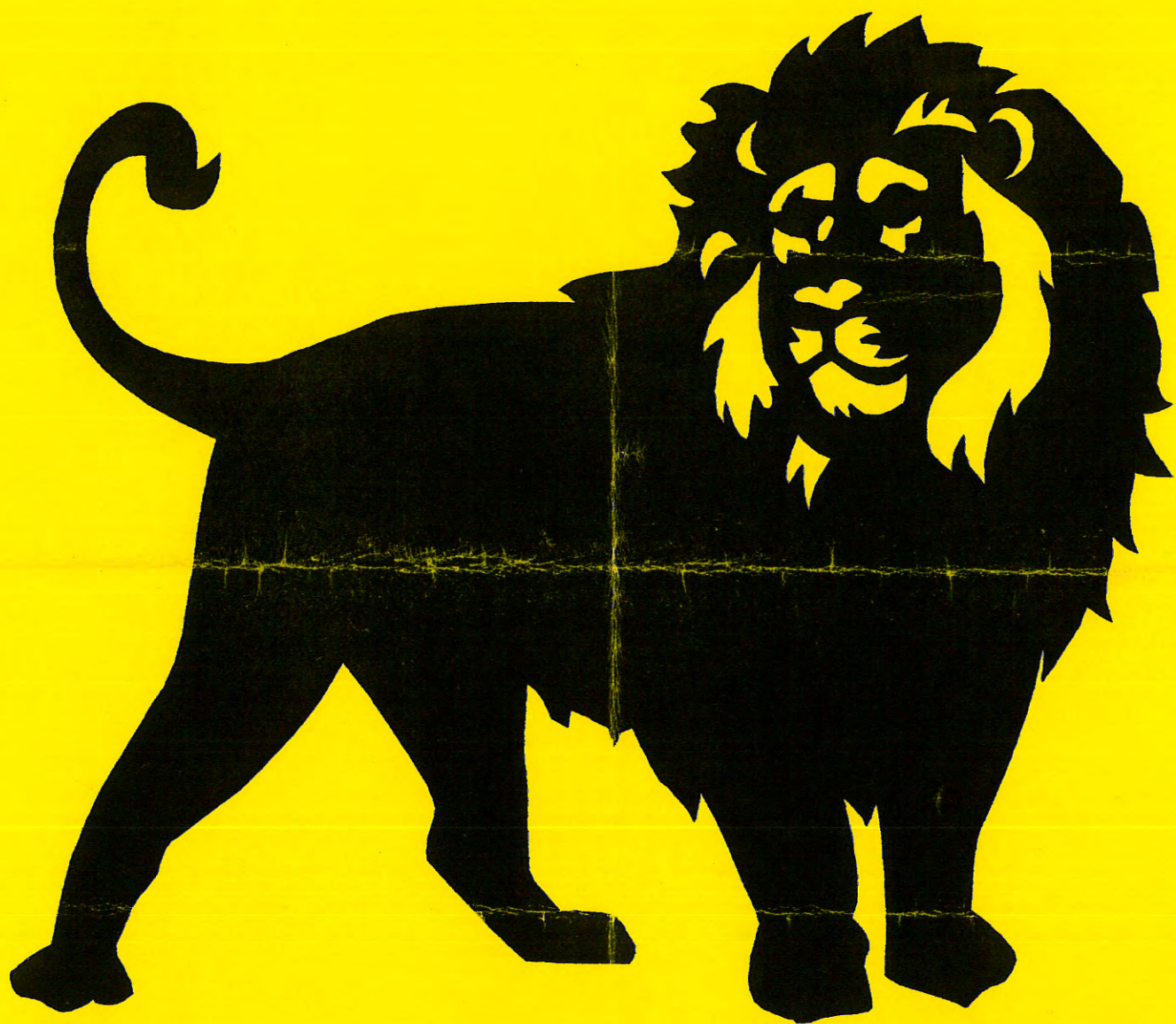
