



MINUTES District 27 B-1 Second Cabinet Meeting Sunday November 14, 2010 Holiday Inn, Manitowoc, WI

- 1. Call to Order @ 9:00 a.m. by DG Jerry Post
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance led by IPDG Len Quinn
- 3. Prayer and Song led by Lion/Lioness Kay Quinn

4. Introduction of Guests by DG Jerry Post, they were past District Governors and special speaker Carroll Jackson from Leader Dog. Carroll Jackson thanked everyone for inviting him to the convention, had a great time.

5. Motion to approve the agenda made by PDG Gary Colton with the second by Lion Ralph Schneider. MOTION CARRIED

Opening comments made by DG Jerry Post. He hopes that everyone had a great time this weekend, if not it was **your own fault**.

6. Roll Call was made by Lion Dave Holschbach, Cabinet Secretary/Treasurer, there were 33 of the 43 cabinet members present.

7. Comment made by DG Jerry in reference to # 5 of the August 1st meeting minutes, the girl is getting a dog via the help from District 27 B2, Two Rivers is working on getting a dog for someone. Motion to approve the Cabinet Minutes from August 1, 2010 made by PDG Tom King, with the 2nd by PDG Ken Wallander. **MOTION CARRIED** Motion to approve the minutes from the Special Cabinet Meeting on August 31st made by Lion Sandy King, 2nd by PDG Tom King. **MOTION CARRIED**

8. Treasurers report was distributed by Lion Dave Holschbach for the first four months of the current Lion year. Motion made by PDG Bob Showers to accept the report, 2nd by Lion Augie Grahl. **MOTION CARRIED**.

9. Tail Twister Lion Helen Mork reported she collected \$ 522 from the 50/50 raffles and also \$273.16 for tail twisting. Cabinet was asked how the 50/50 and special auction proceeds should be disbursed. Total of \$ 668.00 Motion by PDG Vic Voigt to disburse the funds evenly to WLF, Leader Dog, WI Eyebank and Lions Pride, this amounts to \$ 167 each, 2nd by PDG Ken Wallander. **MOTION CARRIED**

10. Only **communications** received from Van Dyne Lioness who donated \$100 to District 27 B1 hearing.

11. Old Business:

A: In reference to # 5 from the August minutes, discussion as to the proper procedure for asking for a leader or companion dog. The first request should be made to the club level, then advancing to the zone level, region level and then district level. PDG Ed Filemyr reported that a companion dog cost approximately \$ 1000 for 1 week of training and materials needed. Group concensus to continue to follow the above step levels. This is a good program to support.

12. New Business:

A. Convention Results were updated by Convention Chair PDG Gary Colton. There were 323 registrations, 65 for Friday Fish Fry, 234 for Lunch and 86 for the Governors Banquet. We need to work on getting more evaluations returned, there were a lot of positive results, the negatives were the length of the speaker talks, need to get more 1st timers, advertise sooner and get more lead time. F. Alert Program chair Lion Mary Jo Abler reported the ALERT program is making slow progress. They are looking at making changes to improve the program. Needs more support and need to get more knowledge out to the public and fellow Lions.

G. LCIF chair PDG Vern Pautz was not present, no report.

H. **USA/Canada** Leadership Forum was held September 23-25 in Milwaukee. PDG Gary Colton said it was 1 of the best ever. 2500-2600 people attended. The motivational speakers were great.

I. **Lions Pride** chair PDG Herb Schneider reminded everyone that the update was given during the convention. Our district is 2nd in donations and we are up to 67% club participation. Our goal is 100% like district 27B2. Pride Ambassadors are available for zone meetings. VDG Merle has had some requests for more information about PRIDE.

J. Quest chair PDG Vern Pautz was not present, no report.

K. **Youth Exchange** chair Lion Sandy King wants to THANK 3 District Governors. PDG Ken Wallander for appointing her as YOUTH EXCHANGE chair. DG Jerry Post for asking her to present a seminar at this past convention. IPDG Len Quinn for asking her to make a presentation at the state Lions convention. One of her counselors was inducted as a Lion this past weekend.

L. **Special Olympics** co-chair PDG Ken Wallander reminded everyone to set aside April 9th in Oshkosh for the Special Olympics. They need about 50 volunteers. Check the website for updates.

N. **Peace Poster** chair Lion Dawn Christensen reported 9 entries this year for district voting. The winner was # 9 sponsored by Winnebago East Shore. The artist was Hannah Hellman and will be awarded \$ 25 from the district. She encourages all of the clubs to participate. New poster kits come out in January. Lion Dawn made a motion to increase the prize money to 3 places, 1st for \$ 50, 2nd for \$ 25 and 3rd for \$15 starting next year, 2nd by Lion Jim McGee. MOTION CARRIED So noted by 2011-2012 budget.

O. **Diabetes/LEHP/Sight Conservation** Lion Kay Quinn is available for club and zone speaking engagements. This year was the first time for a STRIDE walk at our district convention. 13 people participated. It is a start for awareness.

P. **Hearing,Speech & Eyeglass Recycle** Lion Wendy Hartmann has 13 hearing aids approved. Our district has \$10,000 with an additional \$2,000 from the parade of checks. The cost to the district is \$600-\$700 so it does not take long to disburse our funds. Lion Phil Weber will be soliciting clubs for additional funds to help more people. We are the best district in the state for providing this service.

Q. Lions Eye Bank of WI report was given at the convention by Lion Jerry Rabbach, so PDG Tom King had no additional information. PDG Tom mentioned this was a great convention, as a reminder for a \$500 donation, matching funds are still available to make it a KNIGHT OF SIGHT award.

R. **Mission to Mexico** PDG Bob Showers is planning a mission in February, anyone interested get in contact with him. Lion Ralph Schneider reminded everyone that they can use good hospital and school equipment, feel free to contact him.

S. Leader Dog/District Raffle chair PDG Vic Voigt had execellent results for the district raffle, over \$ 3000 raised. PDG Vic would love to see the district back to 100% participation for Leader Dog donations. Lion Jim Mc Gee will be sending correspondence to clubs and is available for club and zone presentations.

T. **State Lions Convention** chair VGD Merle Strelow reported that the convention in May will be in Appleton and our district will be helping run it.

U. District Convention co PDG Gary Colton and IPDG Len Quinn reported earlier.

V. District & State Bowling chair Lion Bill Hilbert was not present, no report.

BB. **Elections & Nominations** chair Lion Ralph Schneider reported elections went smooth. There were 105 votes, with all those running, winning. Advisory vote for next year's convention to be Holiday Inn-Manitowoc.

CC. Advisory/Long Range Planning chairs PDG Tom King, Lion Michael De Baere, and PDG Ed Filemyr had nothing at this time.

14. **Zone Chairman Reports**

A. **Region 1 Zone 1** Lion Fred Gebhart gave an update of their booth at the Calumet County fair. Their exposure was good, they also did Sunday on the Farm. All clubs are involved with Halloween for kids and Christmas parties. Lion Fred mentioned he saw a lot of hugs and smiles all weekend at the convention. This was a super convention.
