ST. PETER LIONS CLUB CELEBRATES ITS 25TH ANNIVERSARY

The Club was sponsored by the Winnebago East Shore Lions Club, and was chartered on January 15, 1977 with 31 members, of which 14 remain as current members. Jerry Guelig was elected as the first President and Chuck Smith was the first Secretary/Treasurer. The Club has since grown to 85 members and has proven to be of a great benefit and a positive impact on the St. Peter Community and surrounding area.

The most unique fundraiser the Club has is the annual super bowl Saturday "Super-Sub Sale", where a 100 yard long submarine sandwich is assembled and sold at each of two Pick 'N Save stores in Fond du Lac. "Teams" of members compete against each other to see which store can sell out first, and claim "bragging rights" for the coming year. The longest standing fundraiser the Club participates in has been the STURGEREE/raffle where tickets are sold on Lake Winnebago, offering prizes for the largest sturgeon speared. This fundraiser was "given" to the St. Peter Lions by the Winnebago East Shore Lions the first year of the Clubs existence and continues to this day.
