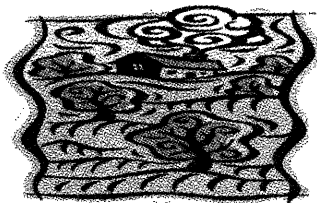

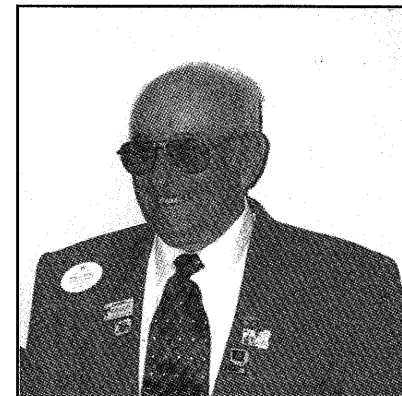

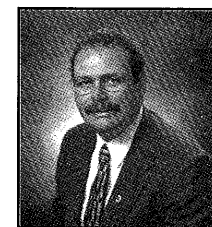

Director Lazarow is a broadcasting executive and spokesman for national advertisers.

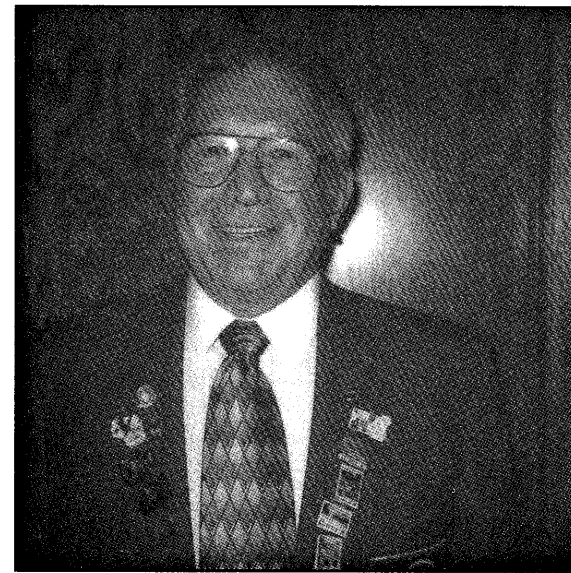
