





He is also a past president of Gamma Sigma Delta and Epsilon Sigma Phi, and is a member of the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars and the Brookings Economic Development Committee.

Director Hansen and his wife, Roberta, also a Melvin Jones Fellow, have four children and five grandchildren.




