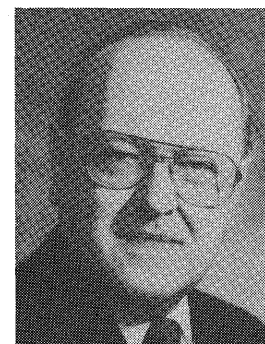


Part Governor Damrow Passed Away on Thursday, Oct. 8, 1998

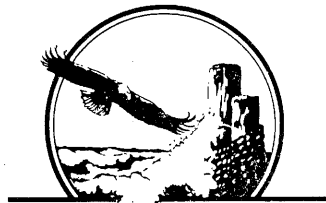

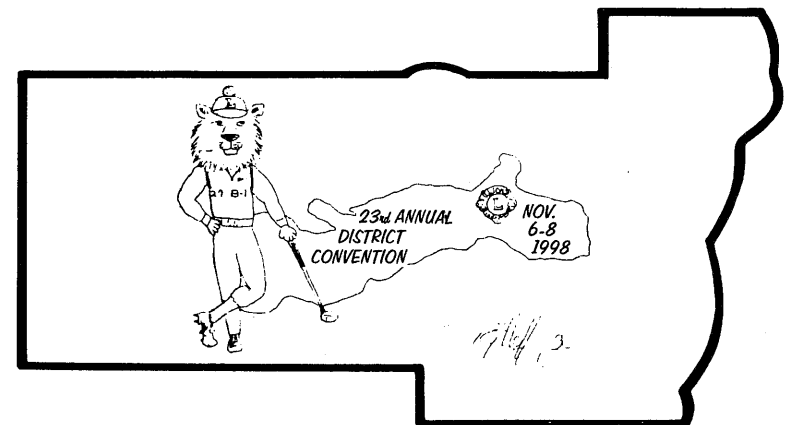
