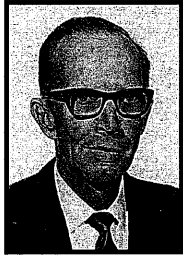

Our Wisconsin Lions Camp owes its origin to a very special Lion, Boy Scout leader and camping enthusiast, Ray Hempel. Inspired during a 1952 hospital visitation by the lament, “Blind kids can’t go to outdoor camps and stuff like that.” He envisioned a solution; a permanent Lions Camp. Lion Ray served as the first Lions Camp Director and eagerly took on its development and in 1959 was recognized as the originator of the Wisconsin Lions Camp by Lions International President, Clarence L. Sturm.

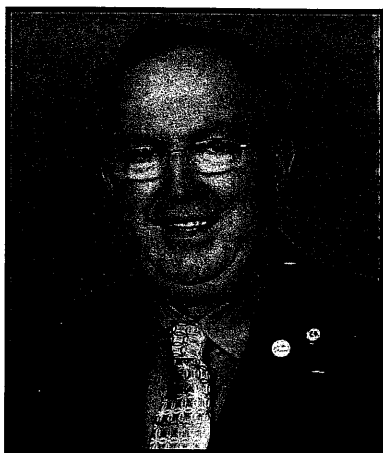

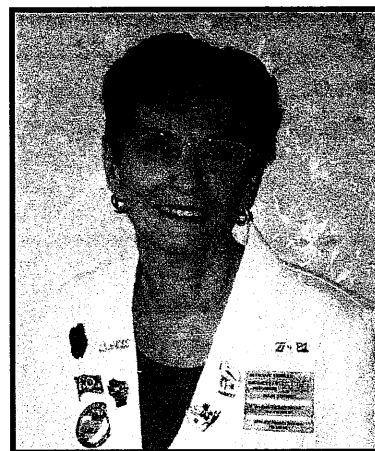
Director Chambers is an agricultural consultant and the mayor of Fillmore.

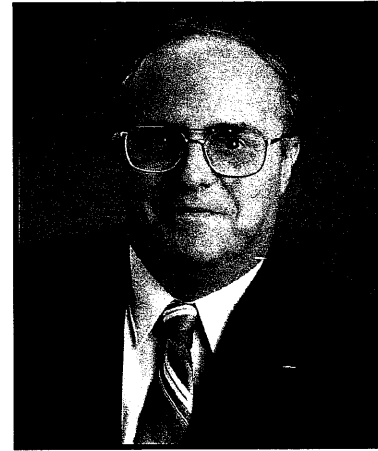

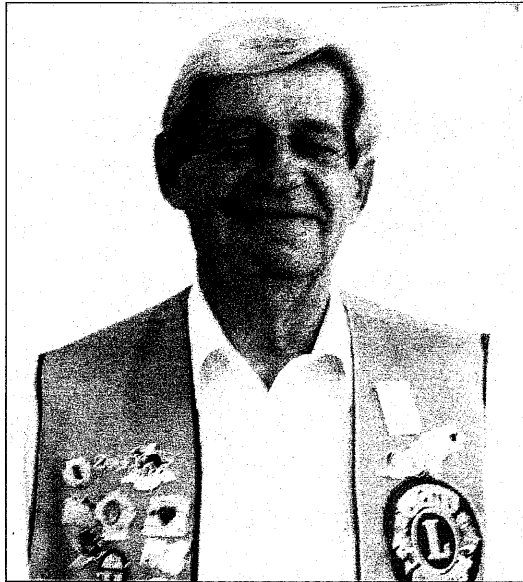

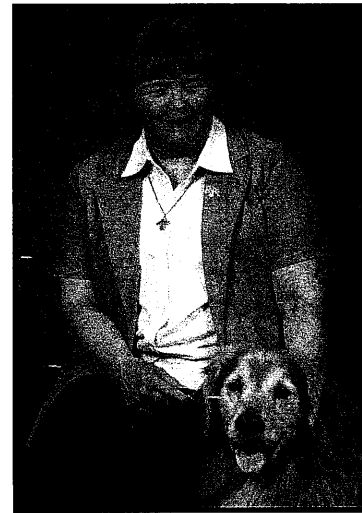

I married and was blessed by three beautiful boys. I now have four grandchildren and love spending time with them even though I get stuck doing all the cooking.

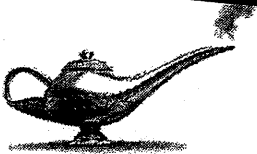
