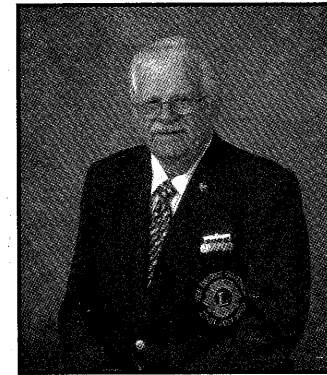

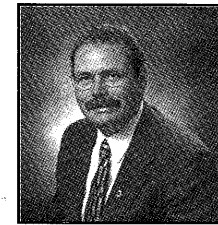

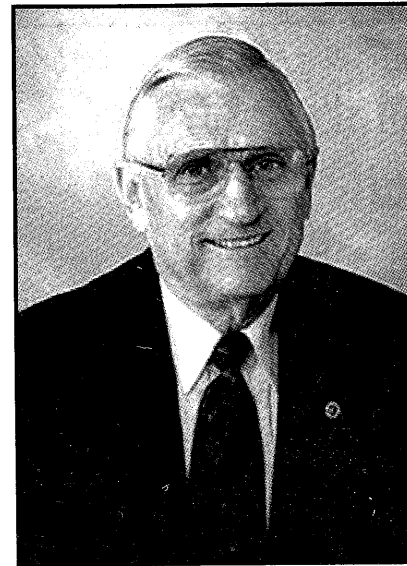

INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR**

In recognition of his service to the association, Director Ouzts has received numerous awards including two Lion of the Year Awards, the 100% District Youth Exchange Award, a District Governor Appreciation Award, two International President's Awards, an International Leadership Award, two International Certificates of Appreciation, the 100% International Club President Award and the Ambassador of Good Will Award, the highest honor bestowed upon a member from the association. He is also a Lions Club International Life Member, a Canine Companion Life Member and a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow.

In addition to his Lions activities, Director Ouzts is active in numerous professional and community organizations. He serves as chairman of the Barrow County Board of Health and of the Adult Learning Center, on the board of directors of the Winder-Barrow YMCA and the Winder-Barrow Boys & Girls Club, a member of the advisory board of the United Way and director of the Barrow County Chamber of Commerce. He is also the recipient of the National Award for one of the 10 Top Automobile Dealers in the United States by Time Magazine and the Chamber of Commerce Citizen of the Year Award.

Director Ouzts and his wife, Carol, also a Lion and Melvin Jones Fellow, have two daughters and five grandchildren.

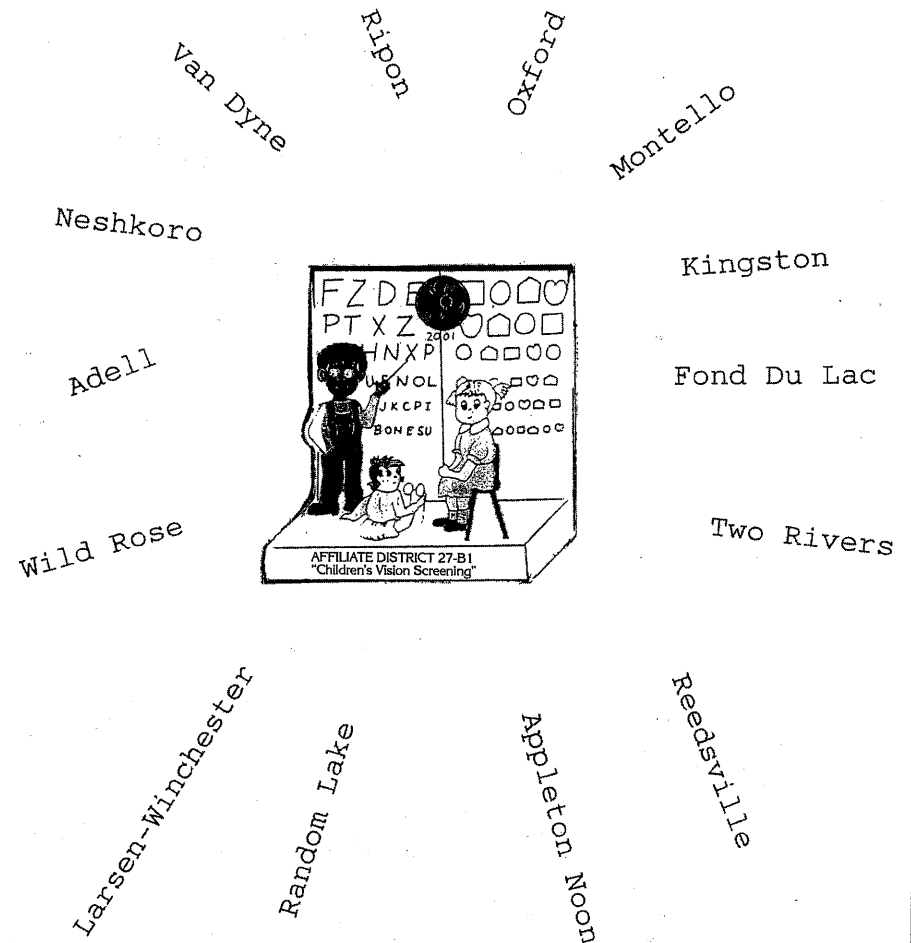

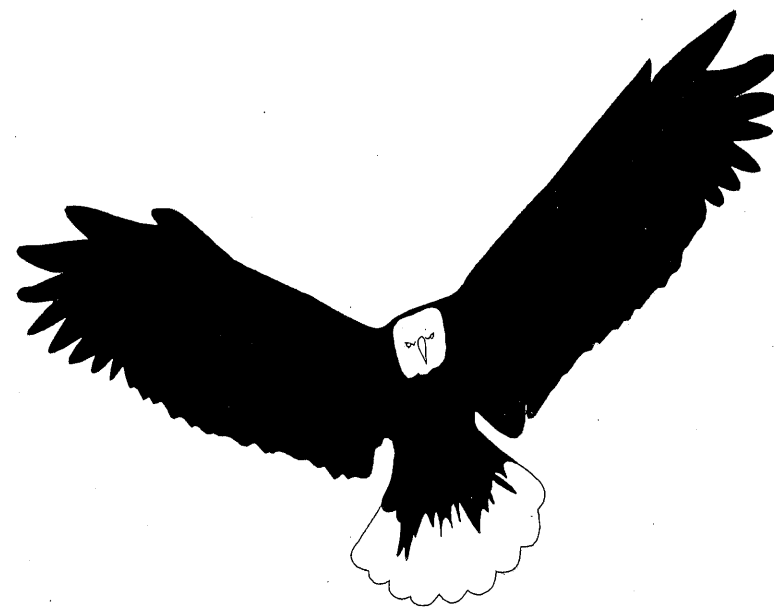

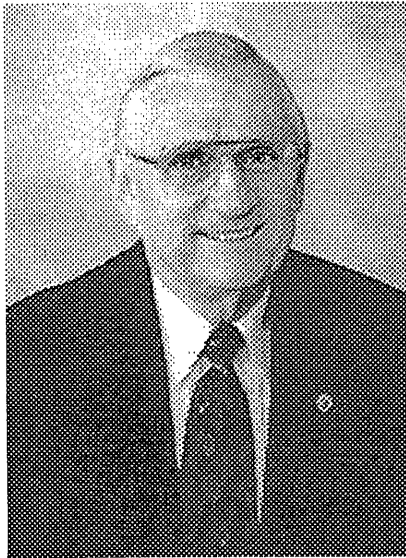
