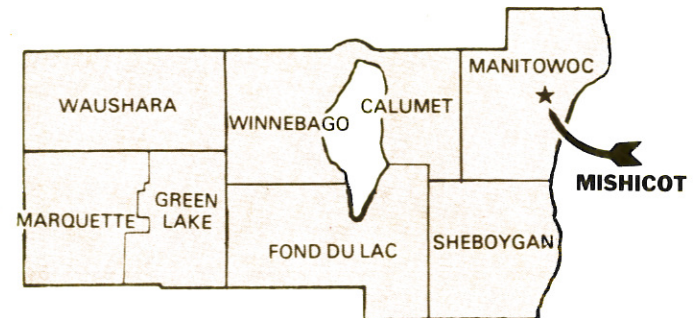

The Village of Mishicot owes its origin to a sawmill being located on the East Twin River. This was established in 1855 by two of the area's earliest pioneers, and it encouraged other immigrants to these parts.

The name Mishicot means "Hairy Legs," which came from Indian Chief Mishicot of the Ottawa Indian Tribe, who was the most noted of the Indians of the vicinity. The Village continued to grow, and became incorporated in August of 1950. The first Village President was Mr. Hugo Holst, who was also the first Lions Club President of the Mishicot Lions.

The facilities we are meeting in were erected, along with an 18-hole golf course, in February of 1964 by Lion Florenz Bagniet, a charter member. Later the motel and another nine holes of golf were added, making Mishicot a fine recreation center. This area also offers good hunting and fishing, making it a fun spot to come to enjoy.

I hope your stay in our area will be most enjoyable, and your Convention successful.
