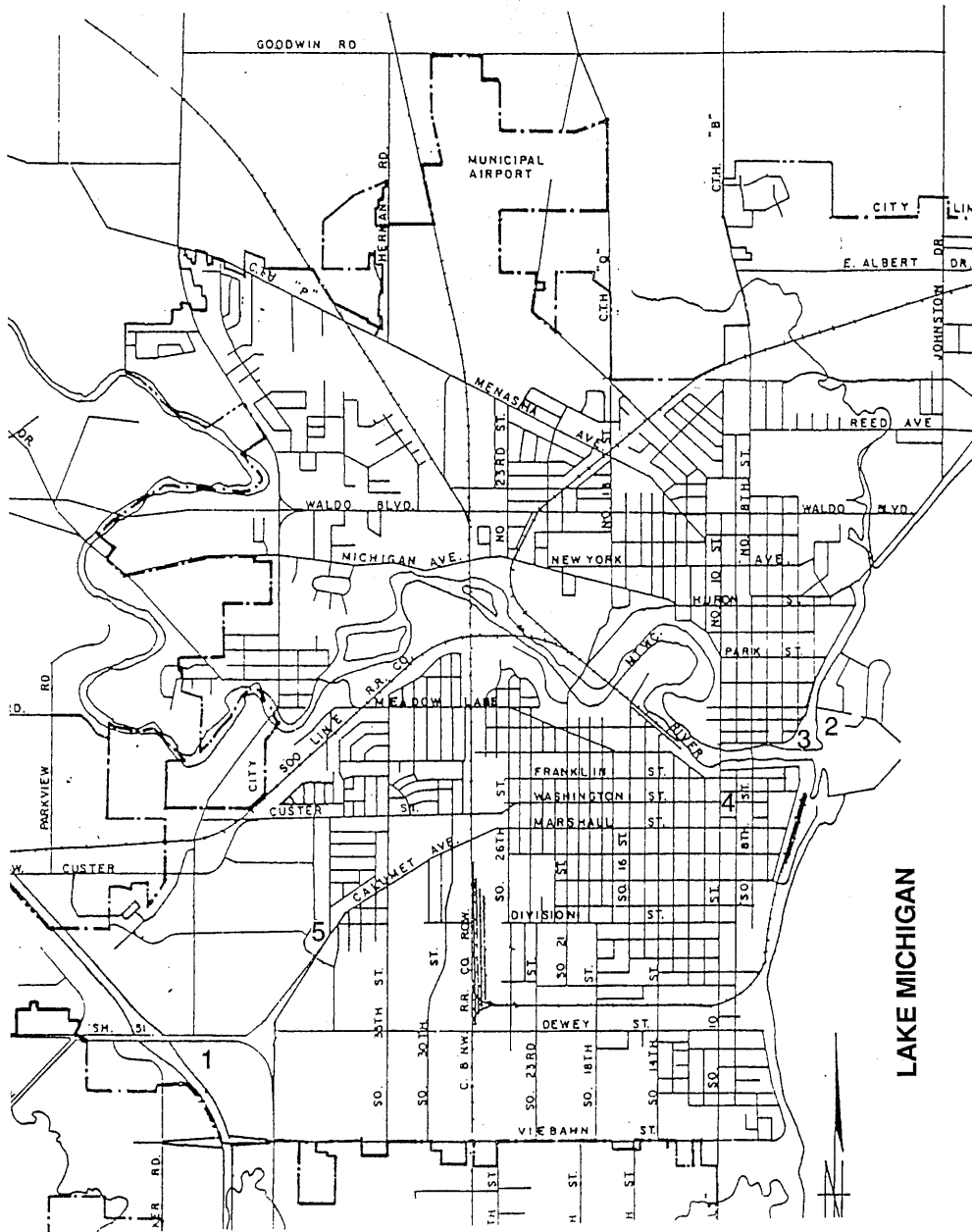
Past Director Barrus is a teacher and coach in the Meeteetse Schools in Wyoming.

A member of the Meeteetse Lions Club since 1965, Past Director Barrus has served Lionism in a number of positions, including District Governor, Club President and Zone Chairman. For his contributions to Lionism, Past Director Barrus has received the 100% District Governor's Award, the Extension Award, four International President's Awards, the International President's Certificate of Appreciation and the Ambassador of Goodwill Award, the highest honor granted to a member by the association. He also holds a Senior Master Key.

Active and involved in his community, Past Director Barrus has been elected Town Councilman, Municipal Judge, and Mayor of the Town of Meeteetse. The recipient of three national education awards, he is also a leader in local educational associations.

Past Director Barrus is single, and is of the Unitarian faith.

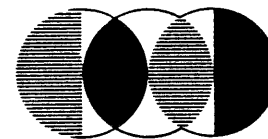

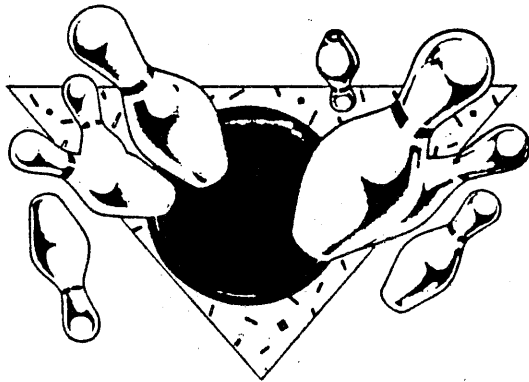

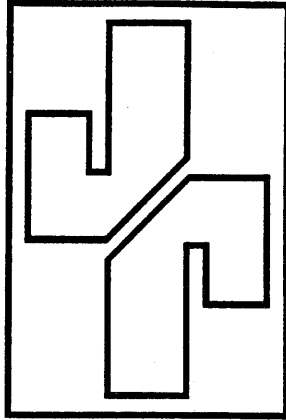
