



Lions Pride Endowment Fund Today's Help, Tomorrow's Hope

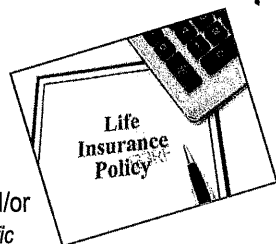
In the present financial climate this is ideal time to look more to the future through a deferred gift; it's the perfect way to help today without changing your current financial status.

Here are some options/suggestions to accomplish your deferred giving to the Lions Pride Endowment Fund:

Designate a specific amount bequest for specific amount in your will or revocable trust.



Make Pride a Beneficiary designation tied to a life insurance policy, IRA, and/or other retirement account (*either a specific dollar amount or a percentage*).



Have a specific stock or mutual fund that has done very well that has a very low basis? A direct gift to the Lions Pride Endowment Fund will enable not having to report a gain on the sale of stock or mutual fund.

If you are 70½ you can give an IRA Rollover Gift. You may designate Lions Pride Endowment Fund as the recipient of your gift. Both you and your spouse may designate up to \$100,000 before the end of 2011. This distribution from your IRA will not count in your current income, thereby giving you the advantages of a 100% charitable contribution without itemizing your deduction.



All of these suggestions are simple ways to accomplish your charitable purpose – either by changing or adding a beneficiary designation.



Contact your estate planner or life insurance agent, or contact the plan administrator of your retirement account to obtain a Change in Beneficiary form to affect your desired change.
