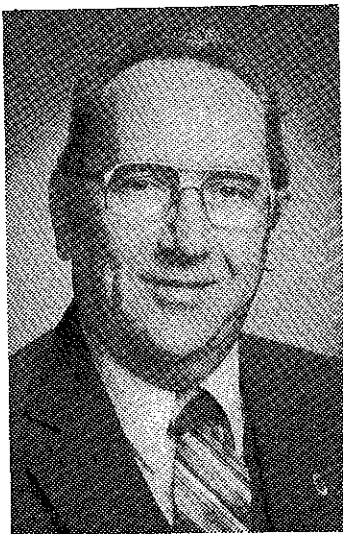
if someone does not go back with something to present, it is their own fault. We certainly welcome and are honored by the presence of our International First Vice President and his wife.

Welcome to the 10th District 27-B1 Convention!

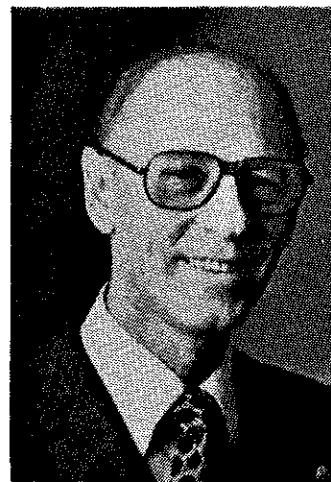
The host club — Mishicot Lions — have been hard at work and are promising us the best and biggest convention that we have ever had. I know they will succeed.

Sten A. Akestam of Stockholm, Sweden, was elected First Vice President of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 68th Annual Convention held in Dallas, Texas, June 19-22, 1985.

Vice President Akestam is self-employed and owner of Sten Akestam House Management Company.

A Lion and charter member of the Stockholm-Johanneshov Lions Club since 1956, Lion Akestam has a 29-year 100 percent attendance record. The many offices Vice President Akestam has held during those years include charter secretary, club president, district governor and multiple district chairman. In 1977, Vice President Akestam was elected to a two-year term as director on the association's International Board. Lion Akestam has also served as a member of the International Credential Committee and the International Election Committee.

For his efforts on behalf of Lionism, Vice President Akestam has received numerous awards, including the 100% District Governor's Award, Master Key Award, Extension Award, eight International President's Awards and the Ambassador of Goodwill Award, which is the highest honor a Lion can receive. Vice President Akestam also is Melvin Jones Fellow.

Vice President Akestam organized the first International Youth Camp in 1961. He also served as leader of Sweden's Red Feather Campaign in 1965, designed to raise funds for cancer research. Later, Vice President Akestam acted as advisor to Red Feather Campaigns in Norway, Finland and Iceland.

Vice President Akestam and his wife, Martha, have three children, Birgitta, Anita and Goran.
