WHENEVER a doubt arises as to the right or ethics of my position or action toward my fellow men, to resolve such doubt against myself.

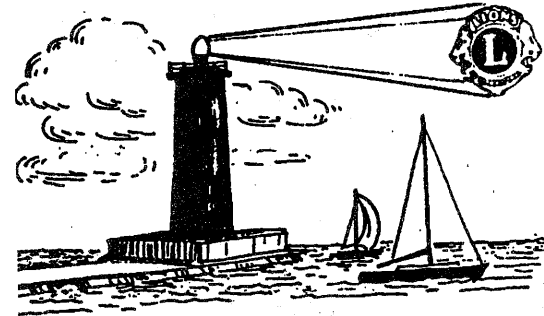

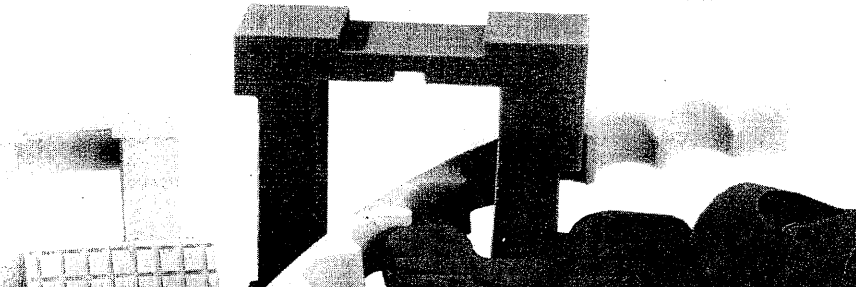

International Director



Gary W. Fry, of Mitchellville, Iowa, USA, was elected to serve a two year term as director of The International Association of Lions Clubs, at the Association's 78th International Convention, held in Seoul, Republic of Korea, July 4-7, 1995.

Director Fry is an educator.

A charter member of the Mitchellville Lions Club, Director Fry has been a Lion since 1972. He has held many positions within the association, including club president, zone chairman, deputy district governor, district governor and council chairman. He also served on the planning committee for the USA/Canada Lions Leadership Forum in 1991, and was Host Committee Chairman of the Forum in 1994. In addition, Director Fry participated in the North American Membership Summit in 1994.

Glenn C. Reiss



As the host club The Sheboygan Noon Lions, we proudly dedicate this year's district convention to the memory of Lion Glenn C. Reiss, our Past President and former Secretary. Lion Glenn was a dedicated Lion with 26 years of perfect attendance and held all offices in Lionism on a Club level as well as District level up to Cabinet Secretary-Treasurer in 1977-1978. He had also served as President of The Sheboygan Falls Lions Club and the Newton Lions Club. Lion Glenn was also Past Director of the Wisconsin Lions Foundation serving in this capacity as one of the few Directors who had been a District Governor first.

Besides serving in Lionism for 26 years, Lion Glenn also served his country for 36 years. He served 16 years active duty in the United States and Saudi Arabia. While in Saudi Arabia, he served as a military advisor to King Faisal. The remaining 20 years of military service he served as military advisor to the Army reserves. During this time he was nominated to serve on the staff of the Secretary of Defense, General McNamara. He was also awarded membership in the Military Order of St. Barbara, The Patron Saint of Artillery Men, normally reserved for officers.

He received many awards during his years of service to his country and Lionism. He received the International Extension Award for organizing the Newton Lions Club. In 1992 he received the International Presidents Appreciation Award. Also in 1992 District 27B-1 honored him by presenting him with the Melvin Jones Fellowship Award. Since his death in 1994 the Lions of Wisconsin have donated to the Wisconsin Lions Foundation \$1,000 to honor him with the Birch-Sturm Award. 26 years of serving his fellow man in Lionism and 36 years of service to his country equals 62 years of dedication.
